

Hello Coaches & Event Supes,

Please see the important info in the email below. Also, at the bottom of this page is important information about the Hovercraft event. Don't let your participants get a penalty for a device not in specs!

Participation Each team can participate in an event with a wrist band securely fastened to their wrist AND an Event Ticket. Event Tickets are available on the website. Wrist bands will be given to coaches AFTER they have turned in their TEAM LIST SIGNED, PERMISSION FORM PER PARTICIPANT IN THE ORDER OF THE TEAM LIST, and a SIGNED CONDUCT AGREEMENT.

Teams can set up their meeting area anywhere OUTSIDE and away from building hallways and doors. NO fire pits or stakes in the ground allowed. Parking is free.

Assistant registration is now closed. All registered assistants and Event Supervisors (ES) will receive a lunch if registered as of today, March 14th. With over 150 assistants and ES's, lunches will once again not be available for team coaches. Your registered assistants will have a name tag and lunch ticket inside the ES registration packet. Let them know where to meet you and at what time.

Schedules have been updated and placed on the website. As always, they are subject to change. There have been location changes so PLEASE use the latest schedules dated 3/13/17. Be sure to click the "Refresh" button.

Event Supes and Coaches register as indicated at the bottom of the event schedule. **Coach/Event Supe** meeting is 7:45 – 8:15 am in room M 104. Attached is the list of items included in the Event Supe packet.

Major tournament sponsor is Id Tech (see attached flyer).

Scanner Forms Just 6 events asked for scanner forms (Meteorology b, Stars B, Anatomy C x2, Disease C, Ecology C x2, Wind Power C) ALL EVENTS MUST BE COMPLETED WITH SCORING TESTS NO LATER THAN 4:30 PM. Please come to scoring as soon as possible to avoid the lines! THERE ARE 32 DIV B TEAMS AND 31 DIV C TEAMS. If the ES is behind in scoring, then the TEAM COACH will be asked to provide assistance.

HOVERCRAFT RULES:

1. Teams will impound during the impound time indicated on the schedule.
2. Teams arriving after impound time has ended will be given the penalty for no impound and told to bring their device at test time.
3. Devices will be checked for specs according to the checklist (see attached). Devices out of specs will be returned to the participants and told why it does not meet the spec.
4. Event Supe will make a note on the team's checklist with specific details on why it did not meet specs and the participants will initial the checklist. They will not be told how to fix the device.
5. The participant is told to bring back the device at their test time and it must meet specs when timing occurs. If it does not, then they cannot test the device and receive a violation. The team can use the 8 minutes to bring the device into spec and test it.
6. Once the team leaves with their out-of-spec device, they cannot return to protest the penalty.

Scanner Form: a copy of the form is attached. In the interest of time (awards begin at 4:30), if at all possible, please write your test using multiple choice questions using the scanner form and include essay questions as well. **LET ME KNOW IF YOU NEED SCANNER FORMS ASAP PLEASE!**

Event Assistants (please see email below) do not need to register online unless they would like a lunch. Deadline to register is March 14th. PLEASE let the assistant know the name of their event they are assisting and the Division as it must be included on the registration.

Rule Update: once again, if event rule indicates ONE SHEET OF PAPER FOR NOTES, and you choose to use two pages taped together, it MUST BE LAMINATED or will not be allowed.

Tournament Schedule has been updated (changes in bold) and placed on the website. Please use the FINAL SCHEDULE available at tournament registration as all others are in DRAFT form.

Team Coaches are responsible for their Event Supervisors, Assistants, participants, and parents/spectators (see “Tournament Penalties” under the “Tournament” tab on the website and share with your teams).

Tournament Day Registration forms are on the website and must be turned in at registration in order to participate (and receive wrist bands).
